- Be proficient in basic math and computer skills.
- Be willing and have the flexibility to travel frequently if necessary.
- Have the desire to help others in need and make a difference along with the willingness to work in disaster-affected environments, which can be demanding and unstable.
- Complete and pass a FEMA-required background investigation, credit check, and fingerprint analysis. All candidates must have physically resided in the U.S. or a U.S. territory for at least 3 of the last 5 years at the time of the FEMA background investigation.
